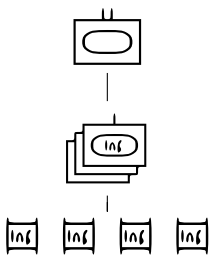

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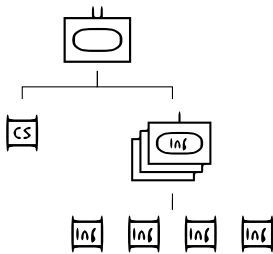

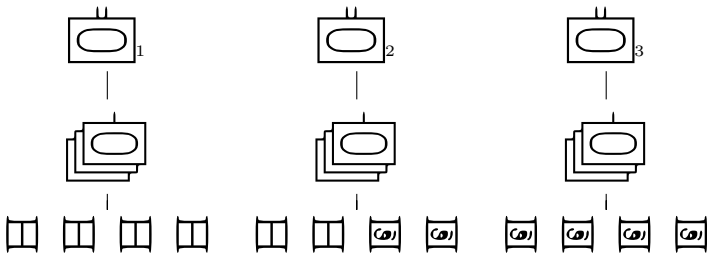
1.1 Tank Regiment 1939 [in Army Tank Brigade]



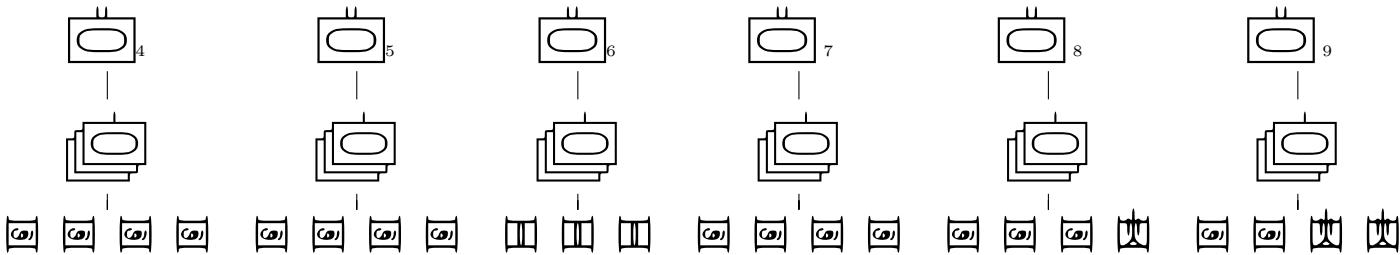
1.2 Tank Regiment 1940 – 1945 [in Army Tank Brigade]
