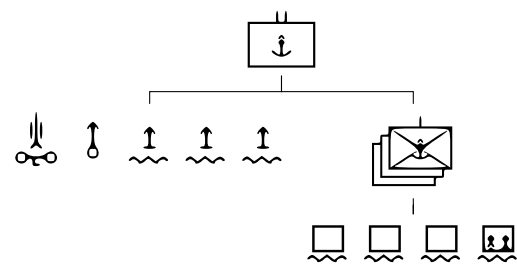
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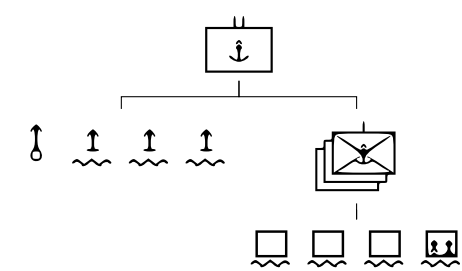

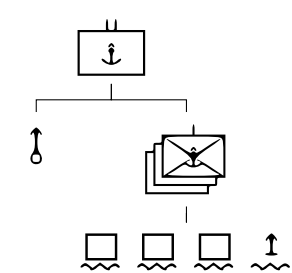
1.1 Marine Battalion D-Series 1941 - Mar 1943



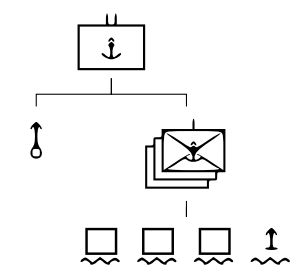
1.2 Marine Battalion E-Series Apr 1943 - Apr 1944



1.3 Marine Battalion F-Series May 1944 - May 1945

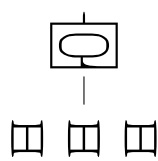


1.4 Marine Battalion G-Series Jun 1945 - 1945

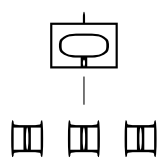

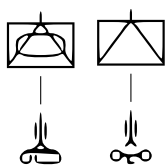

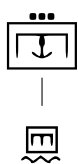
